The Internet has evolved dramatically over the last decade in its ubiquity and hence the scale and diversity of services being offered. As a result, numerous research issues have emerged dealing with content distribution, networking, and application management.

The symposium will focus on recent advances in the broad area of Internet Service and Applications. It aims to foster interaction of researchers and exchange new ideas by bringing together members of the networking, multimedia, and development communities. The technical program of the symposium consists of regular papers, position papers, and works in progress. We solicit original and unpublished research achievements in various aspects including but not limited to the following topics:

- Large scale content distribution
- Network scaling
- Network management
- Peer-to-peer systems
- Multicast, application layer multicast
- Service level agreements for CDNs/ users
- Multiuser systems, multiuser detection
- Load balancing / tier 0 services
- Application scaling / experiments
- Network coding for media distribution
- Metro / local network effects of content distribution

- Impact of wireless on the Internet
- Traffic engineering
